

### **Lionel McGinnis Named GOLF Magazine's Most Improved Golfer**



September 26, 2006, Myrtle Beach, S.C. – Lionel McGinnis of Clarkston, Michigan, was named Golf Magazine's Most Improved Golfer at the 2006 PGA TOUR Superstore World Amateur Handicap Championship, held August 28 through September 1 in Myrtle Beach, South Carolina.

McGinnis finished with a 72-hole gross score of 415 to capture the award at the 23rd annual World Am. The Golf Magazine Most Improved Golfer award rewards the golfer who shows the most improvement in his average gross scores from the 2005 to the 2006 tournament. In the 2005 World Am, McGinnis shot a gross 473.

The 23rd annual PGA TOUR Superstore World Amateur Handicap Championship was held August 28 – September 1 and attracted 3,824 golfers who played on 55 Myrtle Beach golf courses from 49 states and 24 foreign countries. More than 100 golfers played this year in each of the 39 flights, with all flight winners and nine additional golfers who tied advancing to compete in today's 18-hole World Championship play-off.
